Costume Information Sheet "Maleficent & the Magical Kingdom" Nebraska City Dance Studio

1. COSTUME

- Costumes will be tried on in class as they arrive. If the dancer's costume fits it will be sent home. Dancers and parents are to care for costumes until the recital.
- Please put your child's name in the costume and all its pieces.
- Tutu costumes need to be hung upside down.
- <u>Do not iron costumes</u>. If costume(s) are wrinkled, please hang to loosen or steam the wrinkles out.
- ACCESSORIES: Costume that have accessories, check the costume book on how they need to be worn.
- **NUDE LEOTARDS:** Are optional for those who would like an extra layer under their costume. <u>They are required for dancers with quick changes. Or for costumes that are 2 pieces.</u>
- Dancers are not allowed to wear costumes except for Picture Day, Dress Rehearsal and the performances.
- If your child's costume is ruined before the recital they will not receive a new costume and will not be allowed to perform in the recital.

Instructors have indicated specific tights, shoes, hairstyles and accessories. Please check the costume book for details.

2. TIGHTS

- Make sure you have the tights indicated by the instructor
- Have new tights for picture day and performances. We recommend having two new pairs, one to wear and one for back up. <u>No holes in tights.</u>

3. SHOES

- Make sure you have the shoes indicated by the instructor.
- Make sure your dancer's shoes are well fitting, as they will not want to wear them if they do not fit properly.

4. HAIR

- Make sure you have the hairstyle indicated by the instructor
- All hair styles need to be slicked and secured with hairspray
- Ballet buns need to be secured flat against the head with hairspray, hair tie and bobby pins and a hairnet. Ballet bun specifications can be found in the costume book. This instructional video on how to make a ballet bun: <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=S-bXrKWw8vY_</u>For all classes, no bangs are allowed.

5. PICTURE DAY MAKE- UP

• Make up is not required for picture day. If dancers are wanting to wear make- up, we recommend a light, every day look.

6. DRESS REHARSAL/ PERFOMANCE MAKE- UP

- Make up is required for all dancers for Dress Rehearsal and both performances.
 - Make-up must be done for a stream-lined, professional look under the stage lights.
 - **Girls:** should wear bright red lip stick, bright pink blush, a neutral color eye shadow, black/brown eye liner and black/brown mascara.
 - Boys: need a small amount of blush and chap stick/ lip gloss.
